# A "LEAGUE OF OUR OWN"

Now is the time to sign-up for our new VOMPC Summer League. This should be a great opportunity to play petanque, meet club members and enjoy a little "friendly competition" in a "more or less" organized fashion.

League play will allow for each individual to play tete-a-tete (head-to-head) with all other individuals who sign up for the league. More details will follow once you have signed up, but here are the "basics."

Entry fee: \$10 per person

Schedule: Each player will play every other player (at least once) at self-arranged times throughout the summer.

Times: Matches can be played at any mutually convenient time, but it is hoped that league play will facilitate court utilization during weekday evenings as well as weekends.

Matches: Each match will consist of a "best 2 out of 3" contest, with games played to 13 points. Each player will use 3 boules.

Results: Results of each match will be submitted in writing (forms provided) to League Director (Mike Norton). Standings will be maintained and updated at least twice monthly.

Prizes: There will be a trophies for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places as well as a perpetual trophy established for VOMPC League Champion and Playoff Tournament Champion.

At the end of the Summer League, there will be a 'Playoff Tournament' for all league participants at the conclusion of league play (probably in October). There will be a \$5 entry fee for the playoffs and seedings will be determined by final league standings. For the playoffs there will be "A" and "B" bracketing (i.e. top half of league players in "A" bracket and lower half in "B" bracket). Prizes (probably monetary) will be awarded to first three places in each bracket. If you have further questions, please call Mike Norton (938-9128 - evenings).
